### International Service of Process from U.S. or Canada only: Types

**Personal A and B:** « Hand to hand » delivery of documents ASAP, service is completed by an Attorneys at law acting as server, under **Article 10 c** of the Hague Convention of 1965. The Attorney will verify knowledge of English of person served and give proper legal notice and advise. The Hague Apostille is substituted by Consular authentication of service abroad.

The difference between A and B is basically time to serve, on Personal Service B a « Judicial Officer » might be employed instead of an « Attorney/server ».

**Hague Art. 10 (a)** is service by mail. Us as and independent and impartial party will send the documents by Postal or Private carrier and confirm in an « Affidavit » the contents of the shipment, follow up reception of service and signature.

**Divorces:** Documents are served according to Article 10 (b) of the Hague convention, that is by « Judicial Officer », turn around time varies. Authentication of affidavit by Consular agents has an extra cost. Process server can have the documents signed and returned to you.

**Substitute, Affixing and by Publication:** These are indirect services, by leaving in a mail box or given to an adult older than 18, no authentication of Affidavit exist, unless paid apart. Publication is in local newspapers or by inviting to Pick up documents at local Bar Association, Judicial Officer or City Hall.

### Terminology used in Price list:

***Time for Completion:*** Turn around time, service period of time

***Guaranteed:*** Guaranteed delivery of documents or completion of service and also back up in Court as a valid International act of Service of Process.

***Affidavit of Service:*** Written declaration indicating documents were delivered with details.

***Authentication of Service:*** Affidavit of services is Legalized by the Consular agent

***Hague Notice:*** Refers to the obligation to inform defendant of the importance of the service of process act and its possible repercussions in a foreign jurisdiction plus legal advise about the procedure to follow to answer service.

***Reinforced with postal:*** depending on the Jurisdictions and importance of the case Service of Process is also by mail this is a double service for security.

***Private Personal:*** « Hand to Hand » delivery or Private personal and confidential service of process to the specified person.

***Due Diligence:*** Research over defendant to assure day, place, time, conditions and qualify of service.

***Overnight Svc return:*** Returned Authenticated Affidavit by DHL, Fedex....

***Locate, Trace or Registries:*** Obtain copies of Mercantile Registries or identities.
